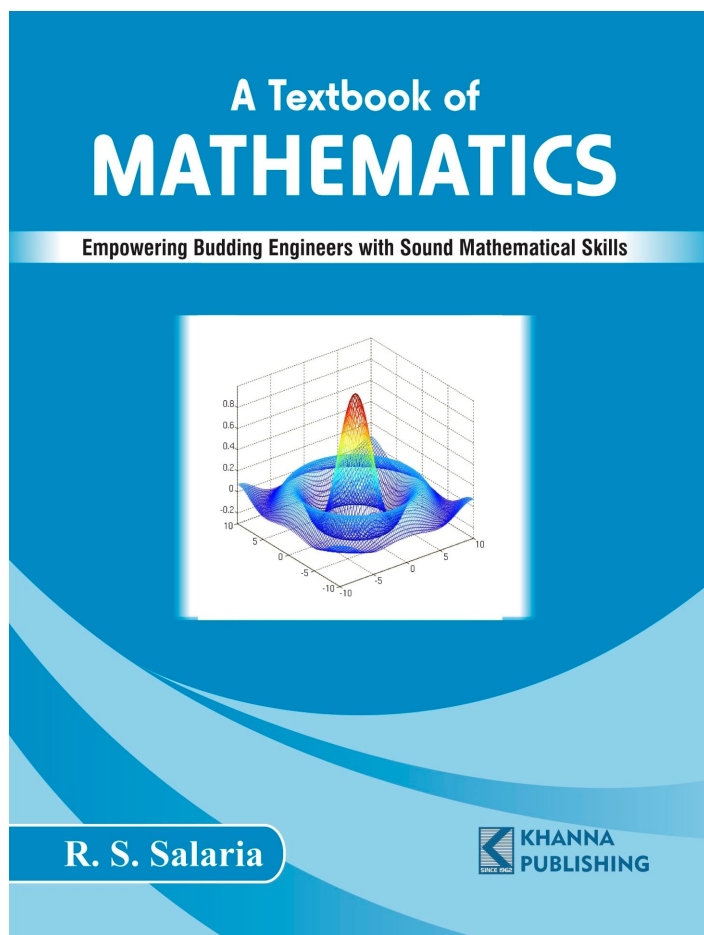




A Textbook of Mathematics
