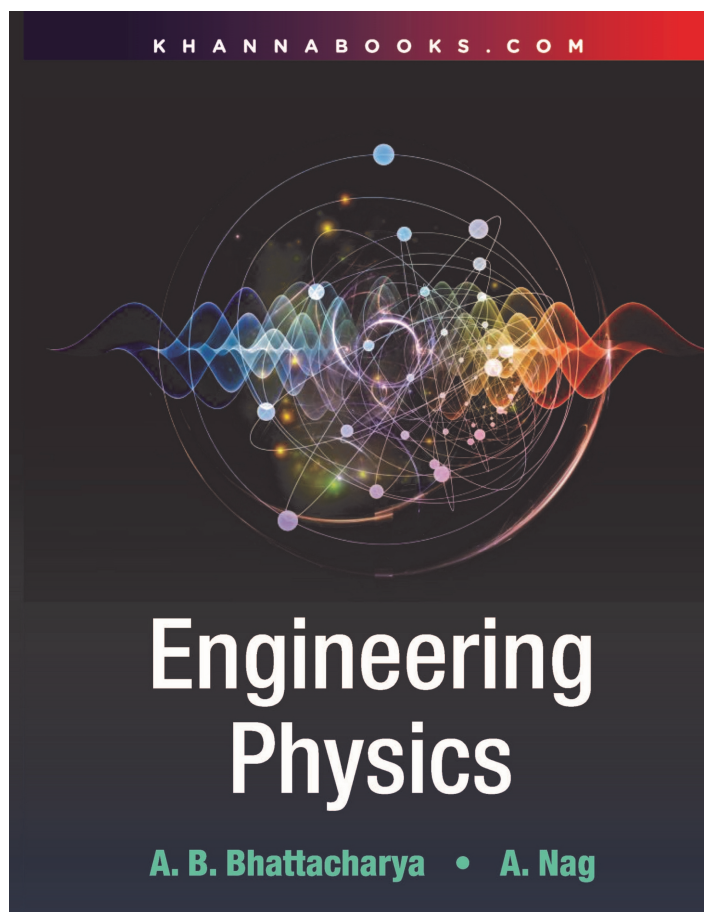




Engineering Physics
