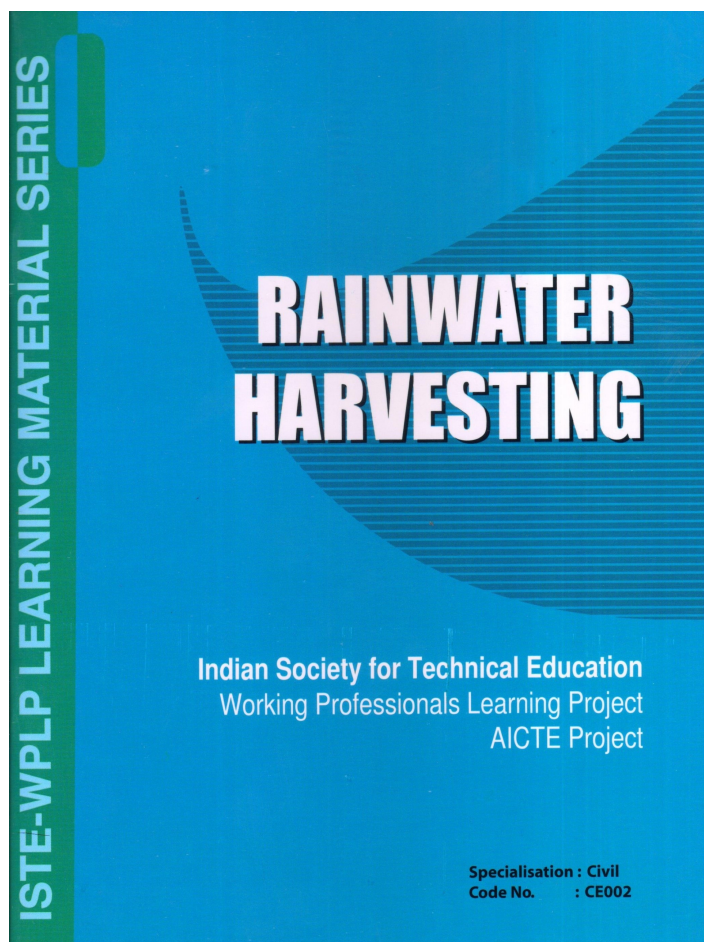




Rainwater Harvesting
