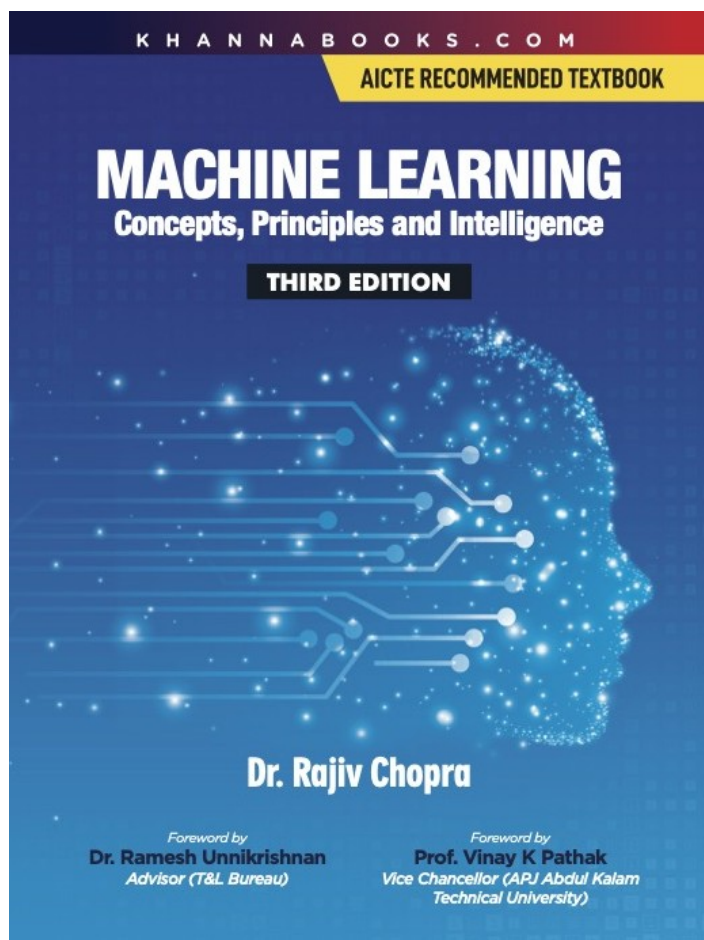




Machine Learning (Concepts, Principles and Intelligence)
