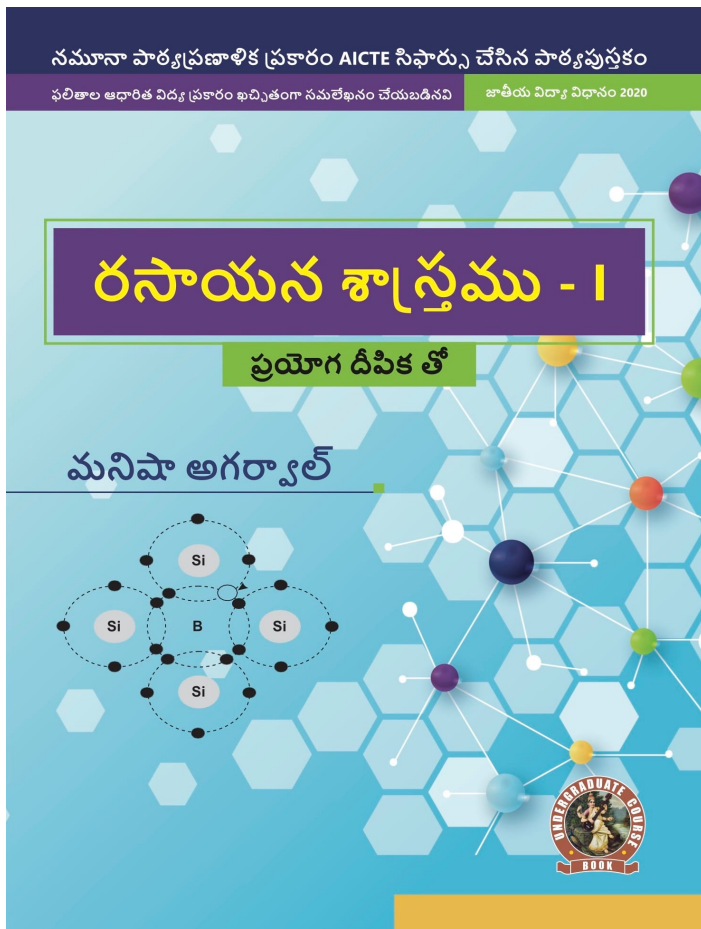




Chemistry I (with Lab Manual)
