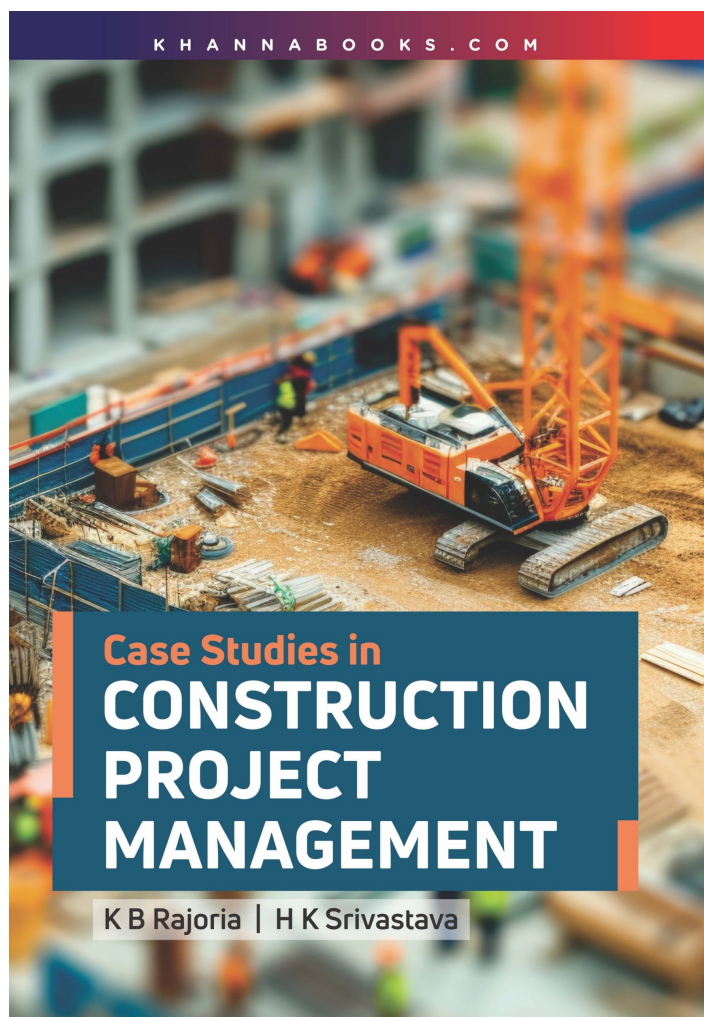




Case Studies in Construction Project Management
